### **Operational requirements**

The re-validation process will be published on the SARS web site

- Existing registered vendors involved in buying and selling valuable metals, must apply within 21 business days to re-validate their registration. The application should indicate:
  - Participation in the DRC, or
  - Notify if the business ceased to operate, or
  - ✓ Notify if the business permanently ceased to make supplies of valuables
- Under certain circumstances, SARS will contact affected vendors to implement the re-validation
- It is however important to note that if a vendor is not contacted, the onus remains on the vendor to re-validate.





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### **Operational requirements**

- Re-validation requests must be sent to the dedicated mailbox including the following information and supporting documents:
  - ✓ VAT registration number in subject line and related VAT certificate
  - Latest 3 months bank statements
  - A copy of the permit issued by the South African Diamond & Precious Metals Regulator (SADMPR), and
  - A list of suppliers; where applicable, including their VAT reference numbers in a worksheet format with as optional, tax invoices from suppliers
- SARS will validate the registration and send an outcome letter, either a confirmation of validation or an unsuccessful notification
- If re-validation is unsuccessful, a re-application should be sent to the dedicated DRC email address in response to issues raised in the outcome letter.





### DOMESTIC REVERSE CHARGE:VALUABLE METAL

#### Background

- ▼ Regulations were gazetted on the 8<sup>th</sup> June 2022
- ▼ Public notice was gazetted on the 24<sup>th</sup> June 2022
- ▼ Effective date is 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022

#### Next steps

- A web page publication will be available from the 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 explaining the DRC, with access to the legislation, explanatory memorandum, public notice and the process to request re-validation
- A VATConnect is scheduled to provide additional information on the DRC, this will be released by 8 July 2022
- An additional month is provisioned for vendor system readiness by the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2022 as means to enable transacting in line with the stipulated DRC regulations.
