Local Content

In terms of Regulation 9(1) of the new regulations to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000, which came into effect on 7th December 2011, bids in respect of furniture must contain a specific bidding condition that only locally produced or locally manufactured furniture with a minimum threshold for local production and content of 85% will be considered.

Suppliers are required to submit completed and duly signed "Declaration of Local Content" form, SBD 6.2 together with Annex C (Local Content Declaration: Summary Schedule), D (Imported Content Declaration: Supporting Schedule to Annex C) and E (Local Content Declaration: Supporting Schedule to Annex C) as part of the bidding documents at the closing date and time.

These documents must be completed in line with the requirements of the South African Bureau of Standard (SABS) approved technical specification number SATS 1286:2011 and the Guidance on the Calculation of Local Content. It is accessible to all potential bidders on the dti's official website <http://www.thedti.gov.za/industrialdevelopment/ip.jsp> at no cost.

The exchange rate to be used for the calculation of local production and content must be the exchange rate published by the South African Reserve Bank (SARB) at 12h00 on the date of advertisement of the bid.

Only SABS approved technical specification number SATS 1286:2011 and the Guidance on the Calculation of Local Content will be used to calculate local content.

The local content (LC) expressed as a percentage of the bid price must be calculated in accordance with the following formula:

$$LC = (1 - X/Y) * 100$$

Where

X is the imported content in Rand

Y is the bid price in Rand excluding value added tax (VAT)

Prices referred to in the determination of x must be converted to Rand (ZAR) by using the exchange rate published by the SARB at 12h00 on the date of the advertisement of the bid.
