"(*b*) The marker shall be the substance supplied under the trade name [Mortrace MP by the Morton Dyes Division of Morton International Limited] <u>Authentix A1 by Authentix Inc.</u> which shall be so added in a proportion equal to or exceeding 20 milligrams of the marker per litre of the unmarked goods."
