Thank you. | An HWSEAT letter of accreditation for all the unit standards advertised, should be submitted. |
| 2 | Seeing that you speak of different courses, in that case of a provider not having first aid level 2 or 3 will they still be eligible | No, all the service provider should be fully accredited for the unit standards on the advert. |
| 3 | Please forward the specification which are not uploaded on etender. | SARS does not send the tender pack to each supplier and the documents are easily accessible on SARS website. |

We are not accredited with the Maritime Safety Authority (Table 5, point 5)</p> <p>We do meet the other criteria. However 7.4.2 prescribes that we can tender for any one or more of the four categories.</p> <p>I have taken a screen shot of 7.3 and 7.4.2</p> | <p>All potential bidders are expected to meet the mandatory evaluation.</p> <p><i>7.3.1 Only Bidders that have met the administrative prequalification Criteria in Gate 0 will be evaluated in Gate 1 for mandatory evaluation. The table below contains the mandatory evaluation criteria.</i></p> <p><i>7.3.2 If a bidder does not meet any of the mandatory evaluation criteria, the bidder will be disqualified, and the bidder's proposal will not be evaluated further.</i></p> <p>If the bidder does not meet the mandatory requirements for Maritime Safety Authority, it does not mean that it cannot submit for other categories.</p> |
