1 EVALUATION OF PROPOSALS (MANDATORY EVALUATION)

This erratum is in relation to the mandatory requirements issued by SARS for this RFP which are contained in **paragraph 7.3, Table 6 of the Main RFP Document**. SARS has officially **removed** mandatory requirement **number 5 “Unemployment Insurance Fund (UIF) Compliance: ‘Bidder to submit a letter of good standing/certificate of compliance with the Unemployment Insurance Fund (UIF)’”**. The below reflects the change made on the mandatory evaluation criteria:

1.1 Mandatory evaluation process (Gate 1)

1.1.1 Only Bidders that have met the prequalification criteria in Gate 0 will be evaluated in Gate 1 for mandatory evaluation. The table below contains the mandatory evaluation criteria.

1.1.2 **If a bidder does not meet any of the mandatory evaluation criteria, the bidder will be disqualified, and the bidder’s proposal will not be evaluated further.**

a. Below is the previous mandatory evaluation criteria that includes “UIF Letter of Good Standing mandatory requirement”
