

## **DRUG TEST KITS SPECIFICATIONS**

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## 1. BACKGROUND

The purpose of this document is to define the scope of work for the Appointment of a Service Provider for the Provision of Drug Testing Kits as and when required for the period of 5 years.

SARS Strategic Intent of compliance revenue collection from identified compliance initiatives coupled to Strategic Objective 3 “ DETECT taxpayers and traders who do not comply, making non-compliance HARD and COSTLY” has a significant bearing in the Customs Business Plan and key outcomes for 2021/22. A key result for Customs is that of an increase in revenue collected and protected as a result of compliance and enforcement interventions.

A contributing factor to achieving this outcome is the availability of drug testing kits. Customs officers at all ports of entry require unhindered access to such kits in the field of operations. This is required as and when suspected contraband is being transported through the Ports of Entry of South Africa. The availability of the portable kits will support officers as it provides for instant clarity on substances testing, in order for the suspected substance to be seized and removed from circulation, as well as affect an immediate arrest of possible suspects. These kits are also vital in preserving the chain of evidence, crucial for a successful conviction.

Drug testing kits would enable officers to conduct drug testing in the field when suspected narcotics are discovered in cargo, luggage, vehicles, trucks and any other smuggling methodologies in the ports of entry

## 2. SPECIFICATIONS

SARS wants to procure drug detection kits that are safe, accurate and easy to use for Customs officials at the Ports of Entry.

Drug detection kits should be able to detect illicit drug in seconds on the following but not limited to:

- Powder
- Pills
- Capsules
- Organic matter
- Liquids
- Substance traces
- Crystals powder
- Surfaces

The drug testing kits must have a sampler in the kit that would be dipped in the suspected illegal substance, after which is placed back in the kit. By breaking the numbered ampoules as

per the instructions, the chemical liquid should run down to the reaction chamber and make contact with the end of the sampler containing the suspected substances. If there is a presence of an illicit drug, a chemical reaction should take place and a positive colour should be an indication of a presence of an illegal substance.

SARS intends to appoint a service provider that is capable of supplying all of the following testing kits but not limited to:

- Cocaine/Crack Testing Kits
- Heroin White Testing Kits
- Heroin Mix Testing Kits
- Marijuana/Hashish Testing Kits
- Cannabis Traces Testing Kits
- Khat Testing Kits
- Ecstasy Testing Kits
- Meth/Amphetamine Testing Kits
- LSD Testing Kits
- Mandrax Testing Kits

Each drug testing kit must only test one (1) drug type

Substances must be packed in boxes of 20 units per box and the lifespan of drug testing kits must at least be 24 months from the date of manufacture
