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<p>The description of the tender is the supply, installation and reticulation of low, medium and high voltage</p> <p>So as we are going through I wanted to find out first of all regarding the line voltage because I saw you there most of the time medium voltage, low voltage as well 230v/32v</p> <p>I want to ask you what type when it comes to the air voltage your line is and you talk about the DB but I didn't see what type of the DB you have, the size for example single phase and three phase</p>	<p>Most of the DBs are three phase supplied however the size of the DB depends on the size of the building.</p> <p>Then in terms of high voltage, we've got MV rooms that are 6.5 Kva</p> <p>Bidders need to provide a rate in terms of the number of hours you need to evaluate and provide SARS with COC for a building of the particular size (square meters)</p>
<p>The regions are divided in terms of the CIDB Grade (5EB, 6EB etc) I wanted to know why? For example, if I am Grade 4, I cannot work in Gauteng that requires a higher grade</p>	<p>Size and number of buildings are not the same in each region therefore budgets and Grades are not the same.</p> <p>Bidders must bid for the region(s) where they meet the minimum grading requirement</p>

<p>Can SARS kindly include an item for travel rate on the pricing template</p>	<p>Refer to Table 7 “Travelling Expenses for Call Outs” of the pricing template</p>
<p>On submission of documents, The document is split into two, File one and file 2. So what I wanted to ask is on the soft copy submission, do we also split it in that sense or do we make it as one document?</p>	<p>Soft copies of Folder 1: TECHNICAL proposal and Folder 2: PRICE and B-BBEE/ specific goals proposal, should be separated and named accordingly on the USB</p>
<p>I want to find out which documents are we going to put in file 1 and file 2 as there are technical documents, administrative documents and pricing</p>	<p>Refer to paragraph 6.5.6 of the Main RFP documents</p>
<p>Should we submit reference letters only or appointment letters plus completion certificates</p>	<p>Bidder must submit 5 reference letters and/or completion certificates not older than 5 years of projects from their current or previous clients</p>
<p>In terms of the locality, should you provide locality for each province for each of the provinces</p>	<p>Bidders must provide proof of footprint in a region(s) that you are bidding for</p>

<p>Do we need different personnel for each province we're bidding for?</p>	<p>Bidders are required to provide one technical proposal for all the regions</p>
<p>In case there's a delay with the COIDA certificate being issued by the Department of Labor for reasons out of my control.</p> <p>There was a letter that came out which stated that the system will be down from the 3 April to the 1 May 2025 and the current letter we have that expires today will be valid until 31 May 2025 due to the problem experienced on the system</p>	<p>Bidders must submit the current COIDA Letter of Good Standing that has been extended.</p>
<p>It is regarding the reference letter. I'm currently doing work for broad properties. But I'm working on different portfolios. Each and every portfolio have their own manager, operations manager and their own in their own company.</p> <p>What I wanted to find out can I use? Well, you guys look at it as one or as different reference letters</p>	<p>The reference letters will be considered if it is for different projects</p>
<p>The award letter, if you haven't started working, but you've got the award letter, can you submit that as a reference.</p>	<p>Refer to 2.1 of the Evaluation Criteria "<i>Bidder must submit 5 reference letters and/or completion certificates not older than 5 years of projects from their current or previous clients</i>"</p> <p>Award letters will not be considered</p>
<p>Can NC and Free State be separated as they are geographically vast provinces</p>	<p>Free state & Northern Cape is one Region therefore cannot be separated</p>
