Can you please clarify the carpet range that must be quoted on for both tenders.</p>	<p>SARS would like to clarify that the required carpet tiles are <b>Belgotex Metro Col: Moon Rock or SARS-approved alternatives; Floornet Col Silver Grey or Top Carpets Hatfield Col: Desert RS3608</b>, as stated in paragraph 3.2.2 of Annexure A – Specification document. Bidders must disregard any other brand that may have been specified in the BoQ and <b>provide pricing based on Belgotex Metro Col: Moon Rock or similar</b>, as referenced in paragraph 3.2.2 of the specification document.</p>
<p>Please confirm and advise on why is the CIDB 4GB needed as the it was not stated on the advertised etenders portal. Please advise if we can still submit a CIDB grade that is less than CIDB GB4? Please note that we have attended the briefing on the 14<sup>TH</sup> April 2026.</p>	<p>Please refer to paragraph 7.3 of the main RFP document for the mandatory requirements. In Table 5, a minimum CIDB grading of 4GB or higher is one of the mandatory requirements. If a bidder does not meet any of the mandatory evaluation criteria, the bidder will be disqualified, and the bidder’s proposal will not be evaluated further.</p>
<p>When you say the document must submitted in an A4 ring bound lever arch file do you mean if we bind in spiral or tape and we submitted in the envelope with the lever arch file will be disqualified? and i dont think the lever arch file will fit in the envelope</p>	<p>No, bidders will not be disqualified.</p>
