Bidders must supply printers that can print both A4 and A3 as per Tray Capacity section of the BRS document. The document specifies a minimum print speed of 23-40 pages per minute (ppm) for Black and White and up to 20-30 ppm for color, and this requirement is particularly directed toward A4- sized documents, which is the most commonly used paper size in our office environments. For A3-sized documents, while the capability to print this size is
