1.	How many points can a Large Enterprise claim on SBD 6.1	A Large Enterprise may claim points only for the specific goals for which it qualifies, provided it submits a valid B-BBEE certificate together with a duly completed SBD 6.1. The maximum points available under specific goals is 20 points. The actual points claimable depend on whether the bidder qualifies for the specific goals listed in SBD 6.1. Certain specific goals points are not limited to EME/QSE and can also be claimed by large Enterprises. Please confirm the specific “Commercially of the Shelf toolset” that also forms part of the system platform, or toolset to which this statement refers	The EPMO currently utilises a bespoke, highly configured Commercially of the Shelf (COTS) software suite. As referenced in the BRS, the commercially of the shelf refers to the existing SARS system that requires replacement by this tender for a large scale PPMIS. The current software suite has been in use at SARS since 2018, however, the EPMO’s ever increasing requirements has outgrown the current solution. Bidders are required to propose a solution that meets the requirements set out in the RFP and the Business Requirements Specification to provide SARS with a full comprehensive PPMIS solution.
