

**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964.-
AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE NO. 1 (NO. 1/1/1098)**

Under section 48 (1A)(a)(iv) of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964 -

1. Government Notices No. R.889 published in Government Gazette No. 21540 dated 7 September 2000 and No. R.331 published in Government Gazette No. 22198 dated 6 April 2001 are hereby withdrawn;
2. the General Notes to Schedule No. 1 are hereby amended to the extent set out in the Schedule hereto in accordance with the decision of the Committee of Ministers of Trade on 19 March 2001 taken under Article 34 of the Protocol on Trade in SADC; and
3. this amendment, in so far as it relates to the amendment of Appendix I to Annex I of Part B, shall be deemed to have come into operation on 19 March 2001.

General Notes

(a) By the insertion after paragraph 5 to General Note K of the following:

"6. In accordance with the provisions of Article 10 of the Amendment Protocol on Trade in the Southern African Development Community the member states mentioned in column A have implemented the said Protocol on the dates specified in column B.
