**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964.-  
IMPOSITION OF PROVISIONAL PAYMENT (VB/126)**

Under section 57A of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, a provisional payment in relation to anti-dumping duty is amended, **with retrospective effect from 11 February 2005** as set out in the Schedule hereto. The provisional payment called for in terms of Government Notice No. R.142 dated 11 February 2005, (as amended by this notice) lapses on 11 August 2005.
