

**NOTES REGARDING AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULES  
TO THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1964**

**16 JULY 2010**

**These notes are issued merely as a guide and both the old and new provisions should be studied in order to determine what the amendment actually entails. These notes have no legal status.**

<i>Provision</i>	<i>Note</i>
215.01/7318.16	The provision for an anti-dumping duty on hexagon nuts, of iron or steel (excluding dome nuts, nuts with non-metallic inserts, nuts of stainless steel, nuts identifiable for use solely or principally on aircraft and collared nuts), of a thread diameter of 6 mm or more but not exceeding 36 mm (excluding self-locking nuts of a thread diameter exceeding 10 mm) originating in or imported from Taiwan is withdrawn, <b>with retrospective effect from 2 June 2010.</b>
