Should we be able to tender separately for the economic data I will appreciate if you will inform us.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- It is important to note that this is not a tender but a request for information (RFI), therefore no respondent is disqualified.- SARS wants a contractual relationship with a single service provider for these services; however SARS encourages the creation of partnerships and joint ventures between service providers in order to provide the required services.- It is important to note that this relationship is between service providers i.e. SARS engages the contractor (Bidder) and does not manage any subcontractors of the bidder- SARS encourages response to the RFI in order to determine if a tender for these services can be issued
