We cannot dictate to the supplier which way to go, however we can highlight the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If the supplier does JV, the BEE level will change. It is the responsibility of the bidder to combine the BEE certificates and submit one BEE certificate. ○ A level 1 supplier can sub-contract more than 25% to any Level BEE and will be given full points for their BEE level. ○ If a Bidder sub-contracts more than 25%, the main bidder must have equal or above the BEE Level of the sub-contractor.
