All other levels will be disqualified.                                   |
| Does the forklift need to enter 20 foot and 40 foot containers to take out cargo   | The forklift does not go into the container to remove the goods. Goods will be moved from the container onto the forklift. Currently we do not allow the forklifts to enter the containers. |
| What brand of forklift is currently on site  | SARS warehouses have various brands of forklifts  |
| The height of 2000mm is this to enter the STD 20 foot containers?  | Yes – although the forklift is not physical entering the container.   |
| The length of 3000mm does this include the forks or only the forklifts   | Entire forklift   |
| Why do you need a 600mm load center on the unit? What length of forks is required?   | Balance of the machine.<br>Please refer to the specification published.   |
| Lifting capacity must be 4.5 tons at 3300mm lift height? So you need to be able to lift products with a weight of 4.5 tons at 3300mm   | 4.5 tons is the maximum lift capacity with a 3300mm maximum height for the lift   |
