3.	<p><i>Bullet 7.5.1 “South African Revenue Service (SARS) has launched eSourcing (SAP NetWeaver Portal (sars.gov.za)) system on 30 October 2017. The new eSourcing Solution has been integrated to National Treasury (NT) Central Supplier Database (CSD), in terms of NT SCM instruction 4A of 2016-2017, which will allow suppliers that are registered on NT CSD to access and respond to SARS tenders online. All suppliers wishing to do business with SARS (current and new) must be registered at NT CSD, with an MA number which will be a requirement to register on the electronic SARS Supplier User Registration page”.</i></p> <p>Question: BidderA do have a valid CSD number. As we do have this valid CSD number do we still have to register on the SARS eSourcing Portal as well?</p>	<p>Yes, Bidders are expected to register on SARS eSourcing Portal, such that, they can be able to submit their proposal on eSourcing <a href="https://bhepreesport0.eservices.sars.gov.za:50001/irj/portal">https://bhepreesport0.eservices.sars.gov.za:50001/irj/portal</a> (if they wish to utilize eSourcing for the purpose of their RFI submission) on and/or before the closing date and time (22 February 2022 at 11:00 am)</p>
