| 1. | On the CCTV camera specification is a description for a 360 thermal camera. Is this a PTZ thermal camera and not a fisheye? | This is a fisheye Camera |

| 2. | The CCTV Indoor camera specification mentions both a 4MP and a 2 MP dome camera but the pricing template only asks for a dome camera. Which of the two cameras should be priced? | Please price on the 4MP camera |
| 3. | The same specification also mentions an ANPR camera but there is no line item in the pricing template. Should we not price for this? | The pricing template will be aligned to reflect this – please refer to the revised price template to be uploaded on the SARS website |
| 4. | On the Network Video Recorder price, NVRs come in different sizes (number of channels, eg: 16, 32, 64, 128) and have different storage sizes. Do we price the NVR based on the estimated number of cameras per Province? This would imply that there is only one office/location per province. Would you prefer we price a standard NVR (number of channels) with standard storage size? This would need to be the same for all bidders. | Please price on a 32 Channel NVR with 4 x 6 Terra byte HDD |

| 5. | The bid document asks for integration of the different systems. Many systems can integrate to each other but if 3 different suppliers are used for the 3 different streams, the 3 systems may not integrate to each other. Will there be allowance for integration development cost if this is the case. | The proposed system must have the ability to integrate to different 3rd party systems. |
| 6. | Both the CCTV and access control system are required to integrate to a parking system as per the business requirement specifications. Is this an existing parking system and are you able to furnish information on the type/manufacturer of the parking system so that we can ensure integration in our proposal. | No, it is not an existing system and this function is envisaged to be used in the near future. Thus, the capability to integrate for these core systems is critical. |
| 7. | Our letter of good standing with PSIRA is older than 3 months and we have had a change of one of our company directors which has not yet been finalised by PSIRA. Will a letter explaining this barrier to a new letter of good standing suffice if submitted with our previous letter of good standing which is older than 3 months? | No - in order to remain fair to other potential respondents the mandatory criteria as stipulated must be adhered to |
